TAX CEILING CERTIFICATE:

If you have an over-65 or a disabled person's homestead exemption you should be benefiting from a tax "ceiling" applied to your school taxes. If you decide to move, you can request a Tax Ceiling Certificate from your former appraisal district that may help reduce the school taxes on your new home.

What happens if you move? First you need to apply for the over-65 exemption or the disabled person's exemption on your new home. When you get the new exemption, you can benefit by transferring a percentage of school taxes paid on your former home.

Please note: only a percentage of your school taxes will be brought to your new property. It is not always in your best interest to move your exemption after January 1.

FIRST RESPONDER SURVIVING SPOUSE

Surviving Spouse of First Responder killed in line of duty qualify for a 100% exemption from taxes on homesteaded property

DISABLED VETERAN EXEMPTIONS:

Veterans with 100% disability or unemployability qualify for a 100% exemption from taxes on homesteaded property

Surviving Spouse of a veteran killed on active duty qualify for a 100% exemption from taxes on homesteaded property providing the spouse has not remarried.

Disability Rating	Exemption Amount
10% - 29%	\$5,000
30% - 49%	\$7,500
50% - 69%	\$10,000
70% - 100%	\$12,000

Veterans over-65 receive the maximum amount of \$12,000, regardless of rating
